## Prerequisites for Adult Leaders\*

\*Supervisor- Any adult staff member that regularly supervises students (one, small group, all) in the café.

- Yes No Roles and duties are clearly defined for adults (traffic flow director, table washer, dismissal etc.)
- Yes No Adults are assigned to zones
- Yes No Adults have a Home Base and are there most of the time
- Yes No Adults are easily identifiable to students and each other
- Yes No Adults have minimal conversations with each other (Pilot Mode)
- Yes No IF adults socialize with students, it is brief and not during a transition (Pilot Mode)

# Arrival Phase

- Yes No Adults stand still at their Home Base
- Yes No Visuals and non-verbal cues are used to support understanding, compliance, and independence
- Yes No Traffic flow is smooth and on-ramps used if necessary

#### Food Service Line Phase

## Get Ready & Get Set

Yes No Adults are synchronized through the end of the Getting Attention Phase

### Get Noticed, Wait & Whisper

- Yes No Only one adult has the role of Announcer
- Yes No The announcing adult gets noticed
- Yes No All adults wait silently for all students to be attentive
- Yes No Announcing adult pauses briefly after the students were attentive
- Yes No Announcing adult anchors attention by whispering one or more words
- Yes No Announcement is brief and/or non-verbal

## Tray Return Phase

- Yes No IF adults lead tray return, they use Silent Select and Stand & Scan
- Yes No Any adults not leading tray return stand still at their Home Base
- Yes No Visuals and non-verbal cues support understanding, compliance, and independence

## **Dismissal Phase**
